 the complexities of modern professional life. This initiative is rooted in promoting
 meaningful connections, shared purpose, personal resilience and city transformation.
- The Thrive conferences, have engaged hundreds of people through thought-provoking events, offering inspiring teaching, workshops and worship for learning, collaboration, and support.
- Past conferences, such as the 2019 in-person and 2020 virtual events, set the stage for this ambitious next step: running a series of conferences across 5 cities in 8 days.

1. Conference Leadership:

- Manage event logistics, speaker coordination, and attendee engagement.
- Oversee communication strategies to promote the conferences and maximize participation.

2. City Network Development:

- Facilitate the establishment of city-wide workplace networks, emphasizing shared values and community-building.
- Organize regular forums and workshops to strengthen collaboration and deepen among cities.

3. Stakeholder Engagement:

 Build relationships with local authorities, community leaders, and corporate representatives.









- Strengthen partnerships with organizations similar to The Business Connection to foster workplace communities.

4. Monitoring and Reporting:

- Track progress toward key milestones and provide regular updates to stakeholders.
